

## March Movies

### March 2 — *The Banshees of Inisherin* — 2022 **\*\*Academy Award Best Picture Nominee\*\***

Although small-town neighbors Padraic and Colm have a lifelong friendship, they find themselves at a sudden impasse that brings alarming consequences for both of them. Colm has announced that he no longer wishes Padraic to speak to him, insisting he will cut off one of his own fingers every time this request is breached. Despite Colm's outrageous, unilateral proclamation, however, Padraic is determined to salvage their relationship. Set against the backdrop of the 1920s Irish Civil War, the film features a gifted cast, unique storyline and beautiful cinematography. Drama/Dark Comedy R for language throughout, some violent content and brief graphic nudity. 1 hour 54 minutes.

### March 9 — *The Fabelmans* — 2022 **\*\*Academy Award Best Picture Nominee\*\***

Loosely based on Steven Spielberg's childhood growing up in post-World War II Arizona, from age seven to eighteen, a young man named Sammy Fabelman discovers a shattering family secret, and explores how the power of movies help us see the truth about each other and ourselves. Drama/Action/War. PG-13 for some strong language, thematic elements, brief violence and drug use. 2 hours 31 minutes.

### March 16 — *Amsterdam* — 2022

"Amsterdam," the latest film from acclaimed writer/director David O. Russell, is a richly intricate tale that brilliantly weaves historical fact with fiction for a timely, cinematic experience. 20th Century Studios' and New Regency's original crime epic is about three close friends who find themselves at the center of one of the most shocking secret plots in American history. Drama/Comedy/Suspense. R for brief violence and bloody images. 2 hours 14 minutes.

### March 23 — *Guillermo del Toro's Pinocchio* — 2022 **\*\*Academy Award Best Animated Feature Nominee\*\***

Academy Award®-winning filmmaker Guillermo del Toro reinvents Carlo Collodi's classic tale of the wooden marionette who is magically brought to life in order to mend the heart of a grieving woodcarver named Geppetto. This whimsical, stop-motion musical follows the mischievous and disobedient adventures of Pinocchio in his pursuit of a place in the world. Animation/Drama. PG for dark thematic material, violence, peril, some rude humor and brief smoking. 1 hour 57 minutes.

### March 30 — *Jerry and Marge Go Large* — 2022

When retiree Jerry Selbee discovers a mathematical loophole in the Massachusetts lottery, he and his wife Marge go on an exciting multi-million dollar winning spree with the goal to revive their small Michigan town. But when a selfish college student cheats the system, Jerry must find a way to make the game fair for all. Inspired by a remarkable true story and featuring an all-star cast. Biography/Comedy/Drama. PG 13 for some language and suggestive references. 1 hour 36 minutes.
