EVENT--BADMINTON:

FORMAT:

Double Elimination Format, rally scoring

Co-ed team of two (2) players.

Match is best of three (3) with first two games played to fifteen (15) and the third, if necessary played to eleven (11)

RULES:

- Co-ed team of two (2) players, and you may have a sub for each gender. However, the 2 starting players must finish the game.
- A coin toss will determine who serves first.
- A serve must be hit underarm and below the server's waist. No overarm serves are allowed.
- Players must serve diagonally across the net to their opponent. After each point scored the server switches sides to serve from.
- If the shuttlecock hits the net or lands out then a point is awarded to your opponent.
- Once the shuttlecock is hit safely by both teams players can use all of the court.
- If a player touches the net with any part of their body or racket then it is deemed a fault and their opponent receives the point.
- Any shuttlecock that hits the line is "out".

- Let may be called by the referee if an unforeseen or accidental circumstance arose. These may include the shuttlecock getting stuck in the net, server serving out of turn, one player was not ready or a decision which is too close to call.
